Stand Up Forklift Attachments - The ICE powered lift trucks are fittingly labeled to the fuel type utilized. Type "G" forklifts are gasoline fueled. These meet fire hazard least standards and is the most common designation for lift trucks powered by gas. Lift trucks labeled "G" are not used in dangerous locations for obvious reasons. Type "GS" forklifts are gasoline fueled and meet all the requirements of a Type "G" forklift and consist of various equipment installed to the exhaust and electrical and fuel system to allow them to be utilized in some hazardous places. Type "GS" forklifts are utilized in similar applications to Type "EE" electric forklifts.

Type "LP" trucks are LPG fueled and do meet the minimum requirements for fire hazards. This is the most common designation used on gasoline fueled lift trucks. The trucks labeled "LP" are not utilized in hazardous locations. Type "LPS" forklifts are LPG fueled and meet all of the standards of a Type "G" truck. They have different pieces of equipment installed to the fuel system, exhaust system and electrical system so as to allow them to be used in some unsafe applications. Type "LPS" forklifts are used in similar applications to Type "GS" and Type "EE" electric trucks.

Type "G/LP" lift trucks are dual fuel models since they can be operated on either gasoline or LPG with no change to the fuel system. Trucks labeled "G/LP" satisfy the minimum requirements for fire hazards. Trucks labeled "G/LP" are not utilized in hazardous places. Type "GS/LPS" lift trucks are dual fuel units as they may be operated on LPG or gasoline without any adjustment to the fuel system. These trucks meet all the requirements of a Type "GS" or Type "LPS" truck and have different machines installed to their fuel system, exhaust system and electrical system, so as to allow them to be utilized in some unsafe applications. Type "GS/LPS" forklifts are utilized in similar applications to Type "GS", Type "LPS" and Type "EE" electric forklifts.

Lift trucks fueled by diesel which satisfy minimum requirements for fire hazards are labeled type "D". These forklifts should not be used in unsafe locations. Type "DS" trucks are fueled by diesel and meet all the requirements of a Type "D" truck and have different machinery installed to the fuel system, exhaust system and electrical system to be able to allow them to be utilized in certain dangerous locations. Type "DS" forklifts are utilized in comparable applications to Type "GS", Type "LPS" and Type "EE" electric trucks. Type "DY" forklifts are fueled by diesel and satisfy all the requirements of Type "DS" trucks and also do not comprise whatever electrical devices installed. These use air starters and comprise provisions for regulating the temperature of truck components. These type trucks are utilized in similar application to the Type "EE" electric trucks.
